
PUBLIC NOTICE

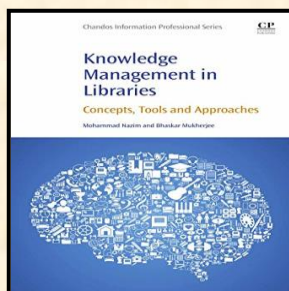

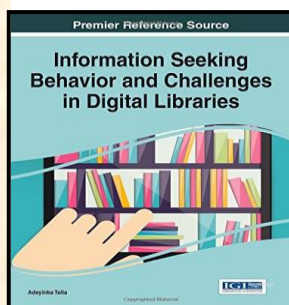
December

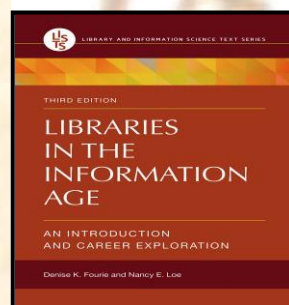

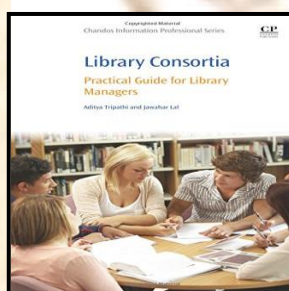
