- 1) On the demand of the Worthy and Curious Professionals, Ranganathan Society for Social and Library Development (RSSWLD) has taken a step forward and opened its conceptual membership to those who wish to involve themselves towards the betterment of society and further the library movement. - 2) IFLA launched the 2019 edition of the Development and Access to Information report. The United Nations 2030 Agenda, agreed by all Member States in 2015, sets out a roadmap towards a richer, fairer, more sustainable world. The Agenda underlines the importance of access to information. Yet to ensure these goals are achieved, it is essential to monitor the performance of member states and of regions, and to share good ideas for implementation.

This is the objective of the Development and Access to Information Report, produced by IFLA in partnership with the Technology and Social Change Group at the University of Washington (TASCHA). The report focuses firstly on the evidence of the different dimensions of access to information, in the context of the UN 2030 Agenda. This reflects the fact that while internet access is increasingly essential, people also need skills to use information, the freedom to express themselves, and a favourable social and cultural context. It stresses that there is much still to do. While internet access and education levels are improving, this is not the case everywhere. Meanwhile, the gender digital divide – the gap between the share of women and the share of men online – is growing, as is the number of countries where people do not enjoy fundamental freedoms. The report also highlights the difference that libraries can make in each of the dimensions of access to information. Drawing on examples from IFLA's Library Map of the World, it stresses how libraries can support learning and inclusion, and improve the effectiveness of government policies through ensuring beneficiaries know about them. They are also key to ensuring the governments and parliaments can make the best decisions for the benefit of others.

- 3) Executive Guide on Digital Preservation released: Digital records are vital assets of any organisation, and their preservation is the responsibility of managers and decision makers at all levels. The Executive Guide on Digital Preservation is intended to assist in convincing senior managers, government officials, and policy- and decision-makers of the importance of preserving their digital assets.

The development of the guide by Digital Preservation Coalition (DPC) was supported by the UNESCO Memory of the World (MoW) Programme and the MoW PERSIST project and its Policy Working Group, with its focus on the sustainability of the knowledge society. Using the Guide, practitioners can tailor and customise the message about digital preservation to their specific situation in a language that senior executives and decision-makers can understand in a way that they can act upon. For example, the Guide describes the key motivators for digital preservation and the related risks and opportunities. The Executive Guide is community led, open to all and free to use. Users are encouraged to both use it and contribute to it, as the Guide is intended to be an evolving document. The Guide is currently published in English. UNESCO is planning to make it available in other languages
