1) TISS launches online portal for school education

The connected learning initiative (CLix) of Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) Mumbai has created an online portal with the educational resources it has created over four years.

On Friday, the portal, CLix Open Educational Resources (OER), was launched with over 100 hours of digital resources and interactive modules for science, mathematics and communicative English for secondary school students.

The course material has been released under creative common licence that allows anyone to use, remix, modify, and adapt and adopt the resources.

Over the course of four years, the modules, which have been designed in Hindi, Telugu and English, have been implemented in 478 government schools in Chhattisgarh, Mizoram, Rajasthan and Telangana.

Padma M. Sarangapani, lead, TISS, said the launch was a milestone in CLix. “The State governments are eager to implement the modules in other schools. Going forward we will be focussing on producing interactive modules and teacher development.”

CLix has been a four-year-long action research project executed by TISS in collaboration with Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and has been funded by Tata Trusts. The project aimed to create a scalable and sustainable model of open education for high school students and teachers. It has since won the UNESCO-King Hamad Prize in 2017 and the OER Collaboration Award 2019.

“A recent study we conducted across all four States showed that girls and students from the marginalised sections who have had access to the modules have seen significant learning gains, when compared to students from schools who did not have CLix,” Meera Chandra, lead, CLix research, said.

Prof. Sarangapani also said their research shows the modules are truly effective only when they are used by teachers in classrooms. “The interventions are not effective on their own. The role of the teacher is critical while employing interactive educational resources.”

2) 'Cover Uncover', questions the way we view the library

The library at Max Mueller Bhavan in Delhi wears a rather distinct look. All the books, DVDs and CDs lie covered in newspapers, their titles hidden and invisible under daily news, lending no clue to its contents. Visitors and readers are met with shock and surprise as they display their unique tendencies depending on the personality they have.

As they browse through the contents of the books, painstakingly, in the absence of their covers, some give up, some patiently snail through their section of interest in literature, travel or philosophy, taking out each book at a time, and browsing through its contents.

After covering the books at Pepper House library at Fort Kochi in the same manner as she did as an artist-in-residence at a residency organised by Kochi Biennale Foundation last year, Nandy, a faculty member at Delhi's College of Art, has covered nearly 13,000 items of the entire media in the library here.

Nandy, who completed her masters in painting from Faculty of Fine Arts, Maharaja Sayajirao University, Baroda, questions the way we enter a library and access its diverse collection of books with her performative exercise, 'Cover Uncover', a part of Goethe Institut's year-long art project 'Five Million Incidents'.

The Gurgaon-based artist says, "What happens if one fine day, that diversity is slaughtered and it all becomes homogeneous. Now we have everything on one scale. All the titles are concealed. What happens when everything becomes uniform. We come with a set notion that we need these books. But if that space is transformed then what do we do."

Over the last two months, a group of four to five art students have been assisting Nandy in her endeavour to cover thousands of books at the library. Speaking about the monotony of the task at hand, she says, "I am exploring the repetitive nature of this, like how some of us do the same thing every single day, and that is also how life is spent. It's like a job."

2nd NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON DEVELOPMENT OF DIGITAL LIBRARIES IN IPR REGIME (DDLIR-2019) (21-22 December 2019)



Madhu Limaye Library of Dr. Ram Manohar Lohiya National Law University, Lucknow organized two days 2nd National Conference on Development of Digital Libraries in IPR Regime on December 21-22, 2019. In his welcome address, Prof. Subir K Bhatnagar, Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohiya National Law University, Lucknow welcomed the guests and highlighted issues related to the digital library and copyright. The Conference was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Dr. Dinesh Sharma, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh. He said that libraries are the heart of any institution.

He elaborated the initiatives such as Shodhganga, NDL, e-PG Pathshala etc taken by the government in making available digital content to the academic and research organizations. Special Guest Dr. Vinay Pathak, Vice-Chancellor, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University, Lucknow.

The conference compendium consisting of full papers was released by the guests. Keynote speaker Prof N Laxman Rao, Emeritus Professor of Library & Information Science, Osmania University, Hyderabad talked about the Open Access movement and Hathi Trust. He briefly explained the role of creative commons and copyright issues with reference to open access, commercial and free resources. He also requested that the awareness of copyright is very much required in digital environments.
