Professional News

• **Public libraries in Karnataka to use cloud technology**

Cloud-based digital libraries will be set up by the department of public libraries in order to help around 10 lakh students in government high schools and pre-university colleges in the state. The technology will also be used in 26 city central libraries and 216 taluk libraries which come under the department. The advanced Digital Rights Management (DRM) protected software had been created by the department. A user or member cannot save, copy, delete, send or print documents that they access through cloud technology. They can only refer the document for 15 days.

Department of Public Libraries director Satish Kumar S Hosamani said the project is being initiated at a cost of Rs 5 crore. Students from Class 1 to Class 12 can access information in their classrooms. School and college heads will be given a user id by which students can access the information. "The department has digitised its books and documents in Haveri, Raichur, Chamarajanagar and Tumakuru district central public libraries with the support of Kerala-based Sai Sanjeevini Trust free of cost," he said.

Hosamani said students can access DSERT and NCERT books, competitive exams books, previous years question papers free of cost. "There are issues with regard to copyright during digitising. At a publishers' meet at Kalaburagi recently, all 101 writer-participants agreed to provide soft copies of their books for digitising and uploading to the cloud," Hosamani said.

• **National Library of Medicine (NLM) Launches "Medicine on Screen"**

The U.S. National Library of Medicine (NLM) announces the launch of Medicine on Screen: Films and Essays from NLM replacing Medical Movies on the Web which debuted in 2013 and hence expanding NLM's engagement with researchers from a variety of disciplines who use the medium of film and video to study the human condition. The NLM is a largest bio-medial library of the world and holds one of the world's largest collections of medical films and videos. It has nearly 40,000 titles, including an estimated 8,000 cataloged titles deemed to be historically significant. Many of these titles are rare or unique with NLM sometimes holding the only surviving copy. Documentary filmmakers have long appreciated learning about and using this unique collection to illuminate complex issues in society and culture from politics to race to class. The visitors to Medicine on Screen will discover significant and insightful essays by researchers from a variety of disciplines and institutions.

• **UK Libraries Expand Resources with HathiTrust**

University of Kentucky Libraries have joined HathiTrust, a growing and global partnership with more than 145 major research institutions and libraries. UK is the first institution in Kentucky to join HathiTrust. This new partnership will boost the accessibility of resources currently available to UK faculty, staff and students.

HathiTrust partner institutions and libraries have contributed more than 16.8 million volumes to the digital library, since launching in 2008. Working collaboratively through member institutions, the organization aims to transform research libraries to serve the wider scholarly enterprise, address large scale challenges, and manage programs that preserve and expand access to the scholarly and cultural record.

UK Libraries consists of nine major facilities on UK's campus. It provides ever-expanding access to quality information resources, teaching and learning programs and services, and excellent learning spaces, as it is the premier research library in the Commonwealth. • **The First Library on a Celestial Body (30 Million Page Archive Being Sent to the Moon)**

The Lunar Library represents the first in a series of lunar archives from the Arch Mission Foundation, designed to preserve the records of our civilization for up to billions of years. It is installed in the SpaceIL "Beresheet" lunar lander, scheduled to land on the Moon in April of 2019. The Lunar Library contains a 30 million page archive of human history and civilization, covering all subjects, cultures, nations, languages, genres, and time periods. The Library is housed within a 100 gram nanotechnology device that resembles a 120mm DVD. However, it is actually composed of 25 nickel discs, each only 40 microns thick that were made for the Arch Mission Foundation by Nano Archival.

The Lunar Library is the third installment in the Arch Mission Foundation's Billion Year Archive initiative, which includes backups humanity, delivered to many locations around Earth and other locations in the Solar System. By delivering many copies to many places, and updating them with new installments on an ongoing basis it is intend to gradually pepper the solar system with the records of our civilization.

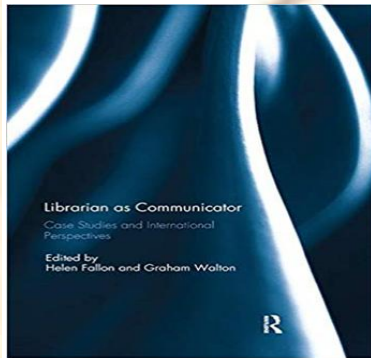

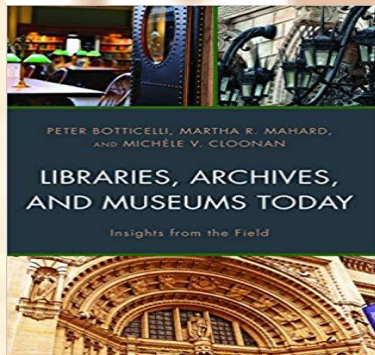

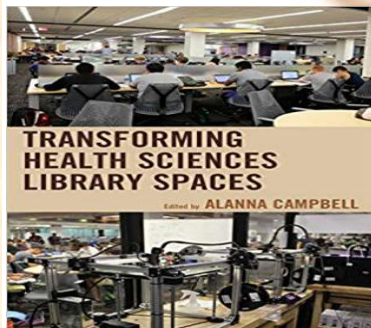
