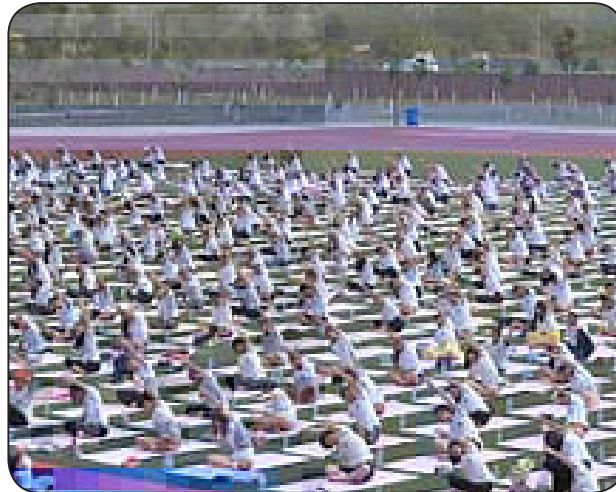

# Rare Materials Stolen and Replaced with Dummy Versions in Russia

Rare 19th century Russian books worth an estimated €500,000 (£434,000) have been stolen from a Warsaw University library and replaced with dummy versions:

The Warsaw University Library has suffered a significant loss, with eighty-seven valuable books, estimated at over EUR 500,000, confirmed missing from the

Warsaw University library building.

This incident, dubbed the largest library heist in post-World War II history, was first discovered late last year and has been under investigation since November.

The stolen books, primarily printed in Cyrillic script in the first half of the 19th century and originating from present-day Russia, are believed to have been targeted for their high value and rarity. According to RMF FM, a private Polish news outlet, the theft was meticulously planned and executed, possibly catering to specific demands from auction houses and antiquarian bookstores in the Russian market.

Anna Wołodko, the former director of the Warsaw University Library (BUW), was dismissed following the revelation of the theft. Her successor, Jolan-

ta Talbierska, in a statement to RMF FM journalist Krzysztof Zasada, described the theft as “the biggest robbery in our library since World War II.”

Investigators, engaging in what has now become an international probe, have identified the thefts as the work of an international criminal gang. The books, housed in the library’s reading room, were systematically replaced with dummies. The culprits, a pair of individuals aged 20-21, used library cards issued under Scandinavian-sounding names to access the valuable prints.

RMF FM reported that the investigation has taken a significant turn with the apprehension of a group member in Latvia, with the arrest being part of a broader investigation encompassing other former Eastern Bloc countries. Efforts to trace and recover the stolen items are ongoing, with the Warsaw prosecutor’s office examining surveillance footage and library lending records to identify and apprehend other suspects involved.

### IFLA joins Sister Organisations in Declaration on the Protection of Cultural Heritage during armed conflicts

In May 2024, the international community celebrated the 70th anniversary of the 1954 Hague Convention for the Protection of Cultural Property in the Event of Armed Conflict (The Hague Convention). Regrettably, this Convention is more important than ever, as conflict and political instability continue to threaten human life and livelihoods, as well as cause large-scale destruction of cultural heritage. The Convention commits States to make effort to protect cultural heritage of all kinds during peacetime as well as during conflict. They are encouraged to bolster preparedness and emergency response measures, develop initiatives to train military personnel in rules of engagement that protect cultural property, list especially important sites for enhanced protection, and raise awareness among the general public and cultural professionals. IFLA joined partners from around the world in the Hague to mark 70 years of protecting cultural heritage at a conference hosted by UNESCO and the Kingdom of the Netherlands.

It is on this occasion that IFLA join sister organisations and fellow founding members of Blue Shield International to reaffirm our calls for the protection of archives, libraries, museums and heritage places during armed conflicts and political instability.
