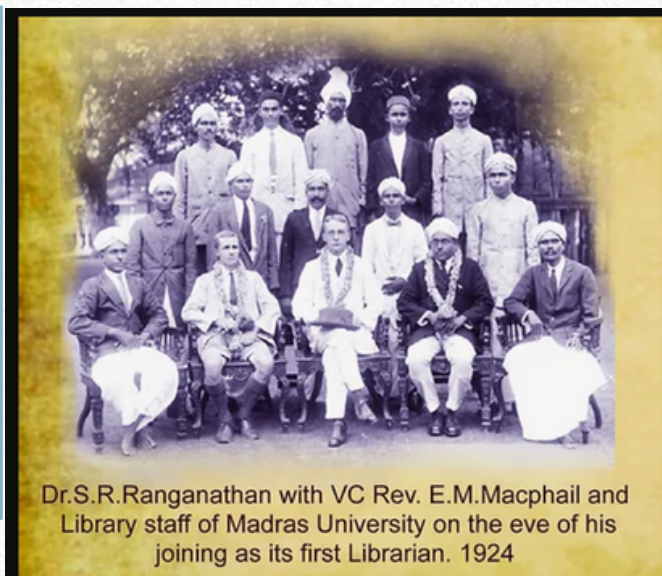

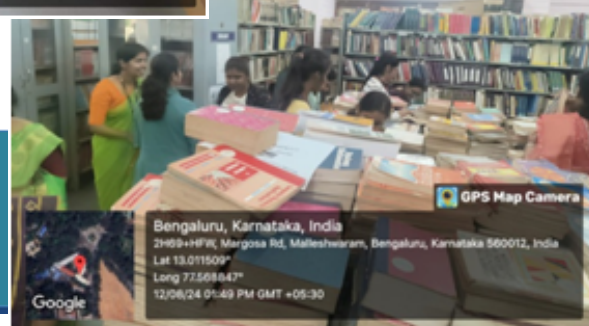


BLDEA's V P Dr. P. G. Halakatti College of Engineering and Technology, Vijayapur
